### Food Recall:

Date of Recall: 13th July, 2016  
 Name of Product: Hot Dog Rolls  
 Distribution: ACT & NSW  
 Hazard: The product is contaminated with metal shavings which may cause illness or injury if consumed.  
 Product Defect: The recall is due to the presence of foreign matter (metal shavings).

Date of Recall: 11<sup>th</sup> July, 2016  
 Name of Product: Chicken Chasseur  
 Distribution: TAS & VIC  
 Hazard: Consumers who have a Crustacea allergy may have a reaction if the product is consumed.  
 Product Defect: The recall is due to the presence of an undeclared allergen (Crustacea).

Date of Recall: 4<sup>th</sup> July, 2016  
 Name of Product: Muesli Bars  
 Distribution: ACT, NSW, QLD, SA, VIC & WA  
 Hazard: Consumers who have a peanut allergy may have a reaction if these products are consumed.  
 Product Defect: The recall is due to the presence of an undeclared allergen (peanuts).

Date of Recall: 28<sup>th</sup> June, 2016  
 Name of Product: Dark Chocolate Bars  
 Distribution: ACT, NSW, QLD, SA, VIC & WA  
 Hazard: Consumers who have a milk, hazelnut and/or almond allergy may have a reaction if these products are consumed.  
 Product Defect: The recall is due to the presence of undeclared allergens (milk, hazelnut and almonds).

Date of Recall: 20<sup>th</sup> June, 2016  
 Name of Product: Lebanese Date Biscuits  
 Distribution: NSW  
 Hazard: Consumers who have an egg and/or wheat allergy may have a reaction if the product is consumed.  
 Product Defect: The recall is due to the presence of undeclared allergens (egg and wheat).

Date of Recall: 15<sup>th</sup> June, 2016  
 Name of Product: Spicy Nibble Mix  
 Distribution: NSW  
 Hazard: Consumers who have a peanut allergy may have a reaction if the product is consumed.  
 Product Defect: The recall is due to the presence of an undeclared allergen (peanut).

Date of Recall: 9<sup>th</sup> June, 2016  
 Name of Product: Sicilian Olives  
 Distribution: NSW  
 Hazard: The product is contaminated with microbial pathogens and may cause illness if consumed.  
 Product Defect: The recall is due to microbial contamination.

Date of Recall: 20<sup>th</sup> May, 2016  
 Name of Product: Satay Chilli  
 Distribution: NSW, QLD & SA  
 Hazard: Consumers who have a peanut allergy may have a reaction if the product is consumed.  
 Product Defect: The recall is due to the presence of an undeclared allergen (peanut).

Date of Recall: 19<sup>th</sup> May, 2016  
 Name of Product: Natural Yoghurt  
 Distribution: VIC  
 Hazard: The product is contaminated with *E.coli* and may cause illness if consumed.  
 Product Defect: The recall is due to microbial contamination (*E.coli*).

Date of Recall: 16<sup>th</sup> May, 2016  
 Name of Product: Ripened Tomatoes  
 Distribution: National  
 Hazard: There is a risk of injury when opening this product.  
 Product Defect: Potential issue with the packaging integrity causing increased pressure in the can.

Date of Recall: 11<sup>th</sup> May, 2016  
Name of Product: Chocolate Bake Mix  
Distribution: National  
Hazard: Consumers who have an almond allergy may have a reaction if the product is consumed.  
Product Defect: The recall is due to the presence of an undeclared allergen (almonds).

Date of Recall: 5<sup>th</sup> May, 2016  
Name of Product: Ice Cream  
Distribution: National  
Hazard: The product is contaminated with plastic pieces which may cause injury if consumed.  
Product Defect: The recall is due to the presence of foreign matter (plastic pieces).

Date of Recall: 4<sup>th</sup> May, 2016  
Name of Product: Chicken Tenders  
Distribution: National  
Hazard: Consumers who have a soy allergy may have a reaction if the product is consumed.  
Product Defect: The recall is due to the presence of an undeclared allergen (soy).

**Consumer Durable:**

Date of Recall: 28<sup>th</sup> July, 2016  
 Name of Product: Girls Dress  
 Distribution: National  
 Hazard: If the defect occurs there is a risk of choking hazard.  
 Product Defect: The polka dots may not be securely fastened and may detach from the dress.

Date of Recall: 28<sup>th</sup> July, 2016  
 Name of Product: Calculator  
 Distribution: National  
 Hazard: If the defect occurs, the batteries may pose a choking hazard to young children or if swallowed may cause internal burn injuries, which may result in serious illness and even death.  
 Product Defect: Product may crack open when dropped exposing the button cell battery.

Date of Recall: 25<sup>th</sup> July, 2016  
 Name of Product: Rubber Squeeze Toys  
 Distribution: VIC  
 Hazard: If the defect occurs there is a risk of choking hazard.  
 Product Defect: Parts of the toys may become detached through normal use.

Date of Recall: 22<sup>nd</sup> July, 2016  
 Name of Product: Dog Biscuits  
 Distribution: National  
 Hazard: If the defect occurs there is a risk of harm to animals including intestinal irritation or intestinal obstruction.  
 Product Defect: The product is being recalled because it may contain pieces of string or twine.

Date of Recall: 15<sup>th</sup> July, 2016  
 Name of Product: Electric Blanket  
 Distribution: National  
 Hazard: If the defect occurs there is a risk of fire or electric shock.  
 Product Defect: The cord between the controller and the blanket may become fatigued, resulting in a potential short circuit or arching.

Date of Recall: 6<sup>th</sup> July, 2016  
 Name of Product: Heater  
 Distribution: National  
 Hazard: If the defect occurs there is a risk of fire hazard.  
 Product Defect: In extremely rare cases, abnormal wear and tear on the fan may generate more surface heat as a result of reduced fan speed.

Date of Recall: 21<sup>st</sup> June, 2016  
 Name of Product: Hand Held Work Light  
 Distribution: National  
 Hazard: If the defect occurs there is a risk of fire or burn hazard.  
 Product Defect: Some materials used in the work light do not comply with the flammability requirements of the relevant Australian standard.

Date of Recall: 16<sup>th</sup> June, 2016  
 Name of Product: Oven Mitt  
 Distribution: National  
 Hazard: If the defect occurs there is a risk of burns.  
 Product Defect: The oven mitt does not meet temperature standards suitable for handling hot objects.

Date of Recall: 7<sup>th</sup> June, 2016  
 Name of Product: Liquid Eye Liner  
 Distribution: National  
 Hazard: If the defect occurs there is a risk of infections, such as conjunctivitis or blepharitis.  
 Product Defect: The finished product(s) have been found to contain an unacceptably high level of gram positive bacteria, Staphylococcus saprophyticus, S. xylosus, and S. lentus.

Date of Recall: 11<sup>th</sup> May, 2016  
 Name of Product: Ceramic Hob Cooker  
 Distribution: National  
 Hazard: If the defect occurs there is a fire hazard risk.  
 Product Defect: Due to a manufacturing error there is a risk of overheating when in use.

Date of Recall: 3<sup>rd</sup> May, 2016  
 Name of Product: Fan Heater  
 Distribution: National  
 Hazard: If the defect occurs there is risk of fire.  
 Product Defect: The heater element and fan assembly could break away from the heater casing.
